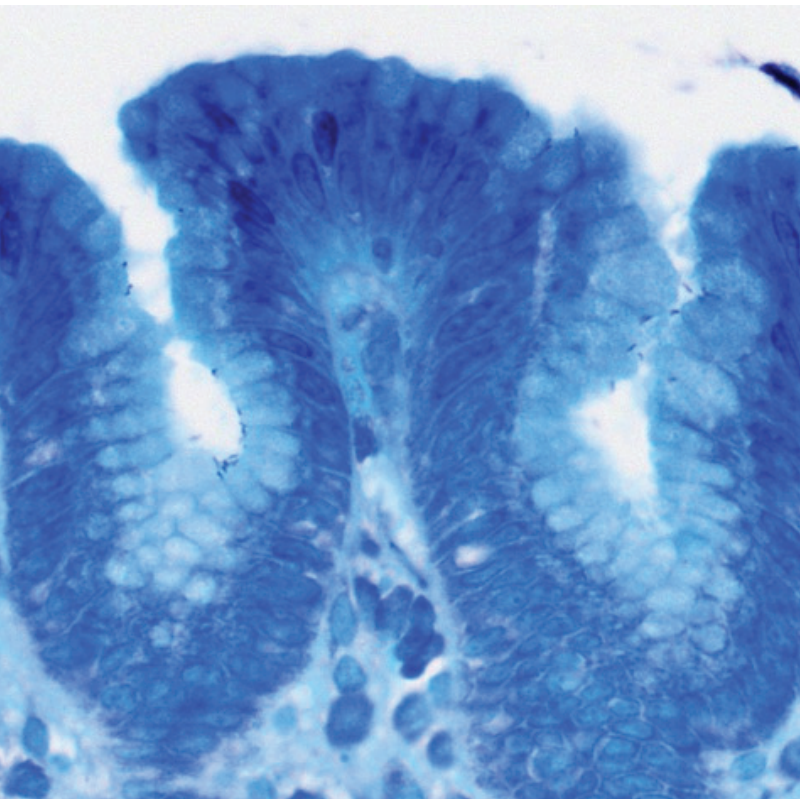

With the stunning **cityscape of Zurich** and the facilities of the venue, we are confident that this congress will be both a memorable and enriching experience.

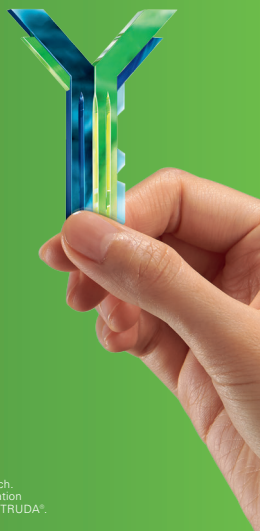
